



#### **Cleansing Silicone Brush**

Upgrade your cleansing routine with our Cleansing Silicone Brush, designed for a deep yet gentle clean. Made from ultra-soft, hygienic silicone, it effortlessly lifts away dirt and makeup while giving your skin a soothing massage.

Perfect for skincare lovers of all ages, this handy facial brush is a must-have for home, gym, or travel.

### How to use the Cleansing Silicone Brush:

- **1.Wet the Brush.** Before using the silicone brush rinse it under warm water to soften the bristles and clean the brush.
- **2.Cleanse Your Face.** Before using the silicone brush, wet your face with water. Apply a small amount of cleanser either directly to the brush or to your face. Please note: The brush is not designed for the eyes, so make sure to remove any eye make-up/product and avoid using the brush on delicate eye area.
- **3.Massage Your Face.** Using gentle circular motions, massage and cleanse your whole face and pay extra attention to problem areas like the T-zone where larger pores and congestion are more prominent.
- **4.Rinse and Dry.** After about 1-2 minutes, rinse your face with water to remove the cleanser and pat your face dry using a clean towel.
- **5.Skincare.** After cleansing continue with your usual skincare routine, like toner, serums, creams, and moisturizers.

#### MAINTENANCE/STORAGE

- **1.Rinse thoroughly after use.** Use lukewarm water to remove any remaining makeup, cleanser/soap, or dead skin cells that may be on the brush. Ensure you thoroughly rinse all parts of the brush, including the crevices.
- **2.Deep cleaning.** For a more thorough cleaning, use a mild and fragrance-free antibacterial soap or cleanser to scrub the bristles and rinse thoroughly with lukewarm water until the soap is fully washed out. Do not use abrasive or harsh disinfectants.



- **3.Disinfect (Optional).** Although optional, we recommend you consider disinfecting your cleansing silicone brush occasionally. You can use a cotton swab dipped in 70% isopropyl alcohol to gently wipe down the bristles. You can also use a UV sanitizing machine that are meant for makeup brushes or cosmetic tools.
- **4.Drying.** Drying the brush properly to prevent bacterial growth is as important as cleaning. Make sure all excess water is removed by shaking the brush and allow it to airdry completely in an open well-ventilated area.
- **5.Storage.** Store the brush in an upright position and avoid storing the brush in a closed cabinet before being fully dried to prevent water from pooling at the base. Store the brush in a safe, dry place, out of children's reach.

#### **FAQS**

### FAQ 1: How often should I clean my Cleansing Silicone Brush?

You should be rinsing your brush after every use to remove any product that may cause buildup on the bristles. Ideally, you should be deep cleaning the brush once or twice a week using mild and non-abrasive soap.

### FAQ 2: How do I know if my brush is clean?

A clean silicone brush must have no visible product residue, no buildups, and there should be no scent or odor lingering from the cleansing products you used. If you detect any of these, kindly repeat the cleaning process.



### FAQ 3: How do I remove stains from my brush?

For stains that cannot be removed by gentle soap and water, try using a gentle makeup remover to help lift the stains. If that does not work, mix a small amount of baking soda and water to form a paste and gently apply paste to stained area. After letting the mixture sit for a few minutes, scrub it with a soft cloth or brush and rinse thoroughly. Reminder to avoid cleaning your brush with harsh chemicals to not avoid stripping or peeling.

#### FAQ 4: Should I be drying my Cleansing Silicone Brush after use?

Yes, drying your brush after use is important. After cleaning your brush, you should always shake the excess water off and patting the brush with a towel, then leaving it in a ventilated area to air dry fully. You should not be putting wet/damp brushes in storage as that might lead to molding and peeling. Always store your brushes away from moisture and direct sunlight to prolong product integrity.

### FAQ 5: What products can I use with my Cleansing Silicone Brush?

Generally, all facial cleansers/soaps can be used with the silicone brush. If you are planning to use it with oil-based products, make sure to test it out first on a small area of the brush as some oils can degrade silicone over time.

#### FAQ 6: Is the brush dishwasher safe?

No, you should not put your Cleansing Silicone Brush in the dishwater as the high heat and abrasive soap/chemicals can damage the silicone, leaving it unusable.



### FAQ 7: How can I get rid of the plastic smell?

It is usual for most new silicone facial cleansing brushes to have a slight plastic smell to it. Although the smell usually dissipates over time, you can wash the brush with mild soap and water for a few times to help lessen the odor.

### FAQ 8: When should I replace my Cleansing Silicone Brush?

Although silicone is durable, repeated use will wear out even the best brushes. It is recommended to replace your brush every 6-12 months, or if the brush is damaged, unusable, and/or not working as intended anymore.
